2. The applicant must display leadership qualities within his community and lodge.
3. Involvement by the applicant in Grand Lodge work should be included in his resume.
4. The applicant must be involved in community work.
5. Only the Lodge of the applicant may submit an application on his behalf for consideration as Mason of the Year.
6. The contents of the resume must contain the above qualities in a two hundred fifty (250) word, 2 – 3 pages, double spaced, typed format, attached to the application for Mason of the Year.
